REGISTRATION FEES:

Register early and save! Up to July 12: \$80.00

After July 12: \$100.00

Allow up to one week to receive an email confirmation of the receipt of your **paid registration**. Please note that postdated cheques will not be accepted.

If you do not have an email address, we will confirm receipt by phone or you may wish to include a **Stamped Self Addressed Envelope** with your registration form.

- **Location?** Between the Rideau River and Range Road, south of Laurier Ave. E.
- **Registration?** Registration opens at **7:45 AM**. You will be given your Exhibitor's Booth Number when you sign in at the registration table.
- **Payment?** By cheque or money order payable to the ***Mental Illness Caregivers Association of Canada***. Please include **one cheque for the registration fee and table rental fee combined – and a separate cheque of \$50.00** for the table deposit, as this will be returned to you at the end of the event.
- **Parking?** You may park on nearby streets and we ask that you kindly respect the diplomatic loading zones. A special permit will be given at registration for extended parking hours where public parking is permitted - limited quantity available on a first-come, first-served basis). You may also arrange to be dropped off and picked up to make it easier.
Note to Exhibitors: The parking area immediately adjacent to the exhibition area is solely for the use of the PUBLIC attending the event.
- **Exhibition space?** Exhibition sites (approx. 12' x 12') are located along the central pathway and river pathway. **Please set-up a min. of 6' away from other vendors and the walkways**. There are NO pre-assigned sites, this is on a first-come, first choice basis.
- **Display? Rentals?** We encourage you to supply your own display. Tables (approx. 10' x 3') may be rented for \$25 per table + a \$50 deposit (chairs may also be rented). Your deposit will be returned to you when the table(s) is(are) returned at the end of the day.
- **Toilets?** Public washrooms are located at the north end of the park. An extra portable toilet will also be located in the exhibition area.
- **Clean-up?** You are responsible for leaving your display area clean.
