REGISTRATION FEES:

Register early and save! Up to July 15: \$80.00

As of July 16: \$100.00

Please allow 2-3 weeks to receive an email confirmation of the receipt of your paid registration. Please note that postdated cheques will not be accepted.

If you do not have an email address, we will confirm receipt by phone or you may wish to include a Stamped Self Addressed Envelope with your registration form.

- **Where is the park?** Between the Rideau River and Range Road, south of Laurier Ave. E.
- **Registration** begins at **8:15 AM**. You are required to sign-in at the registration table where you will be given your Exhibitor's Package/Booth Number.
- **Where do I park?** You may park on nearby streets and we ask that you kindly respect the diplomatic loading zones (unless you receive a special permit at registration – limited quantity available on a first-come, first-served basis). You may also arrange to be dropped off and picked up to make it easier.
Note to Exhibitors: The parking area immediately adjacent to the exhibition area is solely for the use of the PUBLIC attending the event.
- Exhibition sites (approx. 12' x 12') are located along the central pathway and river pathway. **Please set-up a min. of 6' away from other vendors and the walkways.** There are NO pre-assigned sites, this is on a first-come, first choice basis.
- **Display?** We encourage you to supply your own display. Tables (approx. 10' x 3') may be rented for \$25 per table + a \$50 deposit. Your deposit will be returned to you when the table(s) is(are) returned at the end of the day.
- **Payment?** By cheque or money order payable to **MICA (Mental Illness Caregivers Association of Canada)**. Please include **one cheque for the registration fee and table rental fee combined – and a separate cheque of \$50.00** for the table deposit, as this will be returned to you at the end of the event.
- **Toilets?** Public washrooms are located at the north end of the park. An extra portable toilet will also be located in the exhibition area.
- **Clean-up?** You are responsible for leaving your display area clean.

IMPORTANT: NO CARS ARE ALLOWED TO PARK NOR DRIVE ON THE GRASS/PATHWAYS OF STRATHCONA PARK unless prior arrangements have been made!
